NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of sub-clause (ii) of clause (b) of sub-section (4) of section 4 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 read with rule 5 of the Aadhaar authentication for Good Governance (Social Welfare, Innovation, Knowledge) Rules, 2020, the Revenue Department, Government of Rajasthan, having been authorised by the Central Government, hereby notifies that the Registrar, Board of Revenue is allowed to perform Aadhaar authentication, on a voluntary basis, for establishing the identity of land/property owner for generating Aadhaar based unique land/property owner ID, using Yes/No or/and e-KYC authentication facility. The Registrar, Board of Revenue shall adhere to the guidelines laid down by the Central Government for the use of Aadhaar authentication including the following:-

- 1. The informed consent of the resident shall be obtained for the purpose of authentication in terms of section 29 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016. The purpose for which the Aadhaar number and related information are being sought shall be communicated clearly to the resident and specifically the manner in which the Aadhaar number will be collected, stored and used, should be clearly communicated to the residents.
- 2. Provisions related to exceptional handling shall be implemented strictly in accordance with the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 and its associated regulations.
- 3. There shall be no denial of any service or benefit to the resident on account of the failure of Aadhaar-based authentication.
- 4. The resident shall be informed of alternate mechanisms of identification/verification because this approval of usage of Aadhaar authentication is permitted purely on a voluntary basis. EPIC ID may be used, as an alternative document for identification if the residents do not intend to authenticate using Aadhaar or Aadhaar is not available.
- 5. There shall not be a display of the Aadhaar number anywhere in the system and wherever required only the last four digits of the Aadhaar number may be displayed.
- 6. Aadhaar number shall be stored securely in the Aadhaar Data Vault in an encrypted manner as per the UIDAI circular dated 25.07.2017 issued in this regard.



- 7. Complete details of the e-KYC information of the resident shall not be displayed on the screen, instead only necessary demographic details such as first name, year of birth etc. shall be displayed.
- 8. Biometric authentication of residents shall be performed only in assisted mode or controlled environment by the operator registered or verified by the Revenue Department or DoIT&C, Rajasthan.

The consent form to be collected from the resident shall be in the following form:-

I......(Aadhaar holder) hereby give my consent for the use of my Aadhaar Number on voluntary basis to use for yes/no for fetching my identity and other information for purpose of authentication through UIDAI using the Aadhaar OTP or Biometric authentication with UIDAI and to use it in software (e-KYC and Authentication of land /property owner to generate Aadhaar based unique land/property owner ID) created by Revenue Department and DoIT&C.

The consent and purpose of collecting Aadhaar have been explained to me in the local language. The department has informed me that my Aadhaar shall not be used for any purpose other than the purposes mentioned above.

I have been given other alternative means by the department for KYC and have voluntarily chosen Aadhaar-based KYC.

I understand that the Biometric authentication and/or OTP, I provide for Authentication shall be used only for authentication of my identity through the Aadhaar authentication System only for that specific transaction and no other purpose.
